Application Guidelines (International Economics)

1. Recruitment Objectives

In order to cultivate female human resources who can be active on the international stage, Fukuoka Women's University (FWU) has created a new education system consisting of one department with a focus on Liberal Arts and International Studies, and has been devoted to promoting it ever since its foundation. In April 2015, we established an initial two-year doctoral course in the Graduate School of Humanities and Social Sciences (Masters Course) and its final three-year course in April 2017. We welcome a new faculty member who will support our university philosophy by conducting educational and research activities. Recruitment details are as follows.

2. Number of Openings One full-time faculty member : Professor/Associate Professor/Lecturer

3. Field of Expertise International Economics

4. Content of Work

The following duties are expected to be performed as a faculty member of the International College of Arts and Sciences and the Graduate School of Humanities and Social Sciences. Teaching courses are subject to change.

- Courses for the Department of International Liberal Arts (International College of Arts and Sciences): International Economics, Development Economics (both in the 2nd and 3rd year), Seminars on International Economics and Management (3rd year) and Seminars on Graduation Thesis and its related Research
- Common Courses for the International College of Arts and Sciences: First year Seminar I & II and International Economic Mechanisms
- Graduate School of Humanities and Social Sciences (Initial two-year doctoral course): Special Research on International Economics I & II
- Other duties related to the management and operational affairs of the University

5. Conditions of appointment

1) Status:

Full-time faculty member

2) Term of Office:

Five-year contract (reappointment permitted, no term-renewal limitations applied) However, the mandatory retirement age for faculty members shall be 65.

3) Starting Date:

April 1, 2019

4) Pay:

Annual salary shall be as noted in the Fukuoka Women's University Pay Rules for Faculty Members.

6. Qualifications

- 1) Must have a doctoral degree (including an equivalent degree awarded in a country other than Japan) or equal or greater knowledge and experience in the field of expertise
- 2) Must be able to teach courses for graduate school students
- Must be able to teach courses in Japanese and English Any nationality is welcome. However, a sufficient level of Japanese proficiency for the workplace is required.

7. Application Deadline

Submissions via post must arrive by 5 p.m., August 31 (Fri.), 2018

8. Selection Process

Applicants will be chosen based on an initial screening of materials submitted, and subsequently on a secondary screening by interview (conducted for those who have passed the first stage, detailed information shall be given individually). The interview is scheduled to be held on the campus of Fukuoka Women's University in late September. A short demonstration lecture may also be requested at that time. *Travel allowances will not be paid. At the time of the interview, applicants must submit a Certificate of Graduation/Completion (issued by the University he/she attended) and a Certificate of Degree awarded or other documentary proof (copies are acceptable for both).

9. Notification of Screening Results

After consideration, the results will be sent directly to the applicant. (Primarily via e-mail)
